A Bio of our New Potentate

ROBERT E. HARRIS



I cannot begin to tell you how very proud I am to have been elected as the Potentate for Oriental Shriners No. 7. This is the year, Jacque (Jacqueline) and I are heading into a most interesting adventure to share in the work of our great cause, the Shriners Hospitals for Children and for the good of the Order.

Your new Potentate is a military man from a military family. I served our country enlisting in the United States Air Force from April 1972 until the end of December 1992 and retired from the Air Force with almost 21 years active federal service. Plus, had another 20 years in active Reserves, in which I was called up once for Bosnia in 1996.

I met my wife Jacque in England in 1975. While I was working with 3rd Air Force, with Detachment 1, 98th Strategic Wing, with the SR-71\U-2 program, at Royal Air Force Base, Mildenhall, in Suffolk England UK. My Air Force career was interesting with lots of travel to Europe mostly and then the Middle East.

While in the Air Force I worked on the flight line as an Aircraft Electrical Technician, maintaining cargo, tankers, helicopters, executive jets, B-52, FB-111 SAC Bombers to SR-71s and U-2s, and, everything in between. All types of aircraft, even the old birds like the C-47 and B-36.

In 1976 I cross-trained out of working on aircraft to codes and encryption systems known as Cryptography. I employed my training into maintaining communication security systems for voice and data. These Telecommunications Security systems I worked on were varied and I watched them evolve over the next 16 years. I was trained in off-line as well as on-line cipher methods. At that time we had some Cryptoanalysis and manual authentications methods and one time pads and codes learning the old hard ways of doing things.

I was employed multi-agency assigned to Military District Washington and White House Communications Agency, Secretary of Defense and Joint Chiefs of Staff at my last assignment at the Pentagon, which was from 1986 to the very end of December 1992.

This chronicles my military career through the Vietnam War to the end of the first Gulf War. My wife and I moved around the mideastern and southwestern U.S. to England and Germany. Other countries we visited were Iceland, the Azores, Denmark and other European countries. I was deployed for temporary duty to Italy and then Middle East a few times to support our allies in the region.

Jacque and I moved back to Schenectady, NY in 2004 and worked in various roles as a Systems Analyst and Domain Administrator for several companies. I also served for the past eight years as the President of: TREA: The Enlisted Association (The Retired Enlisted Association).



Secretary's report: was received by all. A motion was made by Chief Rabban Robert Harris to accept the report; seconded by P.P. Howard Waller, all were in favor.





Osteogenesis Imperfecta (OI) is also known as brittle bone disease and is a lack of collagen or abnormal collagen in the bones that prevents them from absorbing appropriate minerals and developing correctly. There are many types of OI — each with several symptoms and ranges of complexity and severity. In addition to the possibility of having fractures, OI may cause below average height, early hearing loss, dental issues and orthopedic difficulties including bowed arms and legs, flat feel and scoliosis. Many children with OI have difficulty walking.


