

— Answers to June Questions —

- 1.) The 142nd Imperial session was held from July 3-7, 2016, in Tampa, Florida.
- a.) The Shrine International headquarters in Tampa was established in 1978, when in a special session, representatives voted to relocate the headquarters from Chicago.
- b.) Shrine Centers are located in the United States, including Puerto Rico, Canada, Mexico, Panama, the Philippines, Germany, and most recently, Brazil.
- c.) The last time the Imperial Session was held in Tampa was in 2006.
- d.) Imperial Potentate, Sir Jerry Gantt, is of Arabia Shriners. Tampa is within the jurisdiction of Egypt Shriners. Other Florida Shrine Centers also helped with the Imperial Session.
- e.) The Potentate of Oriental Shriners in 2006 was Ill. Stephen F. Miner.
- f.) From June 30-July 6, 2006, Oriental, at the Imperial Session in Tampa, stayed at the newly renovated Sheraton Tampa Riverwalk Hotel. This was the same hotel Oriental stayed at in 2016.
