— Answers to Sept.-Oct. Questions —

1.) At the Daytona Beach Imperial Session in July 2017, Shriners were introduced to our new National Patient Ambassadors:

Isabella Rose, who at the Shriners Hospital for Children in Chicago, was diagnosed with a submucous cleft palate where the palate is covered by a thin membrane. The cleft was repaired by surgery and she received speech therapy for two years. Living in Florida, she has become a gifted vocalist and hopes to become professional one day.

Emily Mellish was born with spina bifada as well as severe scoliosis (missing eight ribs on her left side), a leg length discrepancy, other orthopedic conditions, bladder and kidney problems. Emily was seen at Shriners Hospital for Children at Erie and later Philadelphia, where she has had numerous surgeries. At age 11, she started making "Beads for Needs" and has raised more than \$80,000 to give back to Shriners Hospital at Erie. She has been seen at NYOSA meetings and other Shrine activities prior to be-coming a National Patient Ambassador for 2017-18.

2.) At the Imperial Session in Daytona Beach in July 2017, it was announced that an additional six ways had been added to those given in Tampa at the Imperial Session in 2016 to forestall dues increases to Shriners in the future. Among these are bundling of services at Imperial Head-quarters, a member benefits program to bring value to members, an infinity credit card, life membership by age, airfare to Imperial Sessions limits, and change fiscal year to align with Imperial's year. Some of these proposals will require new legislation in 2018.

3a.) The 93rd East-West Shrine Game will be played at Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg, Florida, on January 20, 2018.

b.) The East-West Shrine Game has been played at Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg for seven years.






