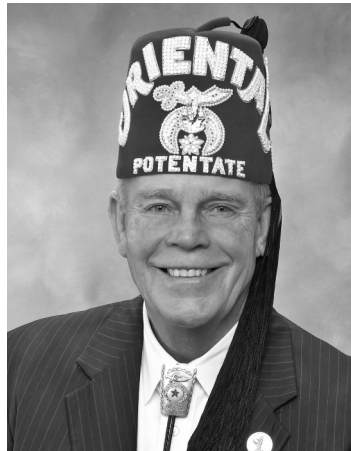

Lady Sally requested and was granted the floor. She offered a Good of the Order announcement.

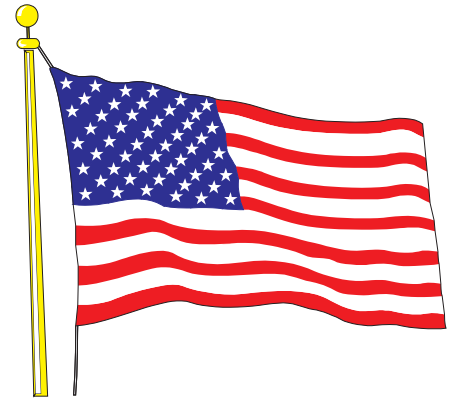

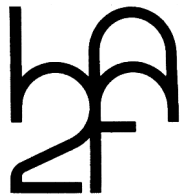
